





Estonian Championships in mountain bike orienteering, BikeEst 2016 and Baltic Championships in mountain bike orienteering.

Date: 01.-03.07 2016

Location: Elva, Tartumaa Tervisespordikeskus



Programm:

01.07 - BikeEst sprin, Elva. Start begins 17.00

02.07 – Estonian Championships middle/Baltic Championships/BikeEst, Elva (WRE). Start begins 10.00

03.07 – Estonian Championships long/Baltic Championships /BikeEst, Elva (WRE). Start begins 11.00

Participants:

In mountain bike orienteering it is allowed for non-Estonian citizens to participate in Estonian Championships outside the medal tally/record/tab. The licence is not mandatory. To compete for the title of Estonian champion in mountain bike orienteering 2016 the participant must be either:

- 1) Estonian citizens,
- 2) Members of Estonian Orienteering Federations orienteering clubs.

All Estonian Championships participants must have a valid Estonian Orienteering Federation licence for the year 2016. The licence must be obtained before the competition day. In mountain bike orienteering the competitors orienteering club is determined during registration and during the season a competitor may only represent one orienteering club. Classes: MW 17, 20, 21, 40, 50, M60.



Terrain

Elva city and its surrounding forests, Udernapalu ja Illipalu flatlands. Inside and around the city is a thick grid of roads, streets and tracks. In Illipalu and Udernapalu is a grid of rides but there are less roads and smaller paths. The density of the forest is variable. There are open forests and thickets. Outside the city there are overgrown paths and there are fallen trees. Land forms. Mainly flat or slightly wavy. Between the flat areas flows the Elva river, which is surrounded by its valley (slope 10-15m) and the valleys around Illi and Pulga rivers (slopes 5-10m). There are mapped plains where hills are up to 20m high.

Starting order: In classes W21 and M21 the starting order is determined by the world ranking (http://ranking.orienteering.org/). Competitors, who are not in the world ranking, are drawn to the beginning of the starting list.

Start interval in all classes for sprint is at least 1 minute, for middle at least 2 minutes and for long at least 3 minutes.

Punching system:

Touchfree SI AIR is used for punching.

Registration and entry fees:

Registration is through <u>www.osport.ee</u> page until 27.06.2016 (every day separately), except classes MW21 on 02.07 and 03.07, where competitors register only through IOF Eventor. (http://eventor.orienteering.org/Events).

MW21 - 12 EUR/day

MW40, 50, M60 – 12 EUR/day

SI-card can be rented from the organisers for 2 EUR/day.
