COMPETITION CENTRE - LAYOUT AND MARKINGS

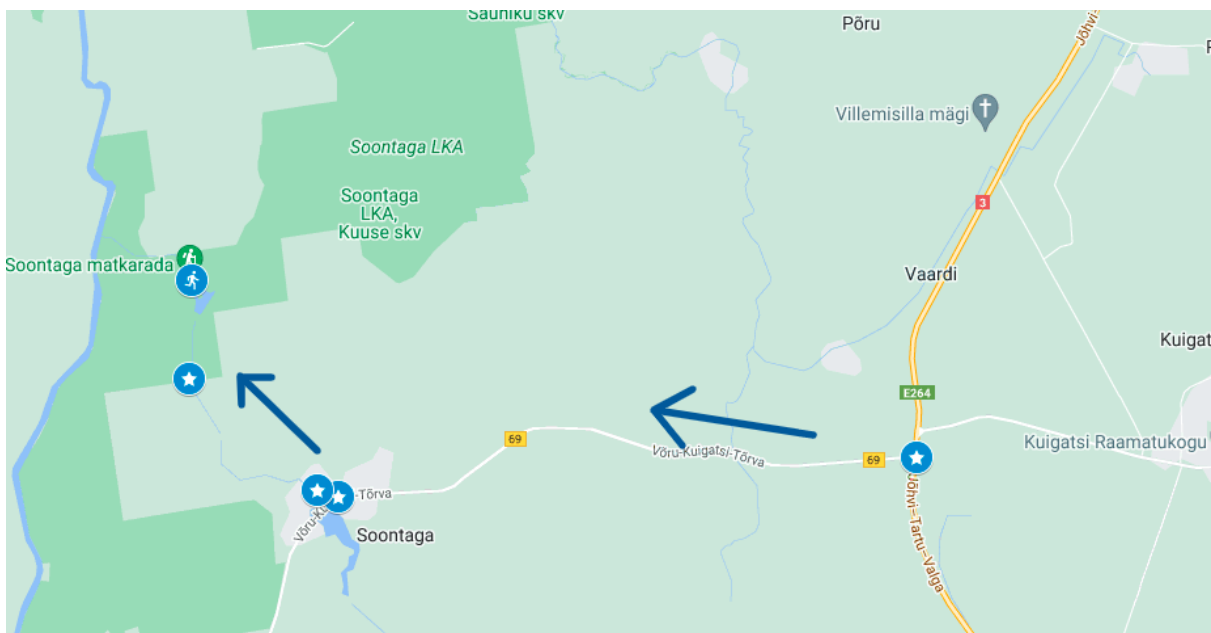
The competition centre is located in RMK Soontaga camping area.

Distance from different cities: 65 km from Tartu, 35 km from Valga, 70 km from Põlva, 215 km from Tallinn.

Exact coordinates: 58°01'19.4 "N 26°04'03.9 "E ([link](#)).

Markings are from the Tartu-Valga road from the Kuigatsi-Tõrva road junction. The road to the centre is from the village of Soontaga. The race centre is located in the camping area of RMK Soontaga. Parking by the road. Follow the parking instructions. Exit the centre in a northeasterly direction towards Purtsi.

STARTS

On the first day of the race (03.09), the individual start is drawn on the basis of the protocol. The pre-start is 3 minutes. 3 min before the start, the competitor's SI-card number will be checked. 2 min before the start additional legends can be confirmed. 1 min before the start the competitor moves to the side of his class card holder. The start interval is 2 min.

On the second day (04.09) there will be a chasing start based on the results of the 3 days (except for the marked course). Pre-start 5 minutes. Competitors will be placed in the order of their starting time. When entering the pre-start, the competitor's SI-card number will be checked. At the pre-start (START 1) additional legends can be attached. The chasing start will last for one hour from the first competitor in the class. Competitors who have lost more than one hour in total over the three days, or who have not scored a result on each day of the race, will start at 2 minute intervals after the five-minute start.

ADDITIONAL POINT DESCRIPTION

For all classes except open marked course and open course, there will be additional point descriptions at the start on. There will also be tape and scissors at the start. There will be no assistants to help with the attachment of extra legends.

OPEN COURSE AND OPEN MARKED COURSE

It is possible to attend the open course from Start 1. The start will be open on both race days for 1,5h after the first start of the day, i.e. on 3.09 between 14:00-15:30 and on 4.09 between 10:30-12:00. You can register on the spot at the information desk for €10/day. There is no chasing start on the open course.

From start 2, children can go to the open marked course with a parent or instructor. On both days of the race it is possible to start until 1,5h after the first start of the day, i.e. on 3.09 between 14:00-15:30 and on 4.09 between 10:30-12:00. There is no chasing start on the open marked course.

FOOD

Hot food will be provided by the Siidrimõisa lihaköök outdoor café in the competition centre.



WASHING

Washing facilities will be available in the competition centre on both days.

PARKING

Parking is free of charge. When parking, please follow the instructions of the parking manager.

COMPLAINTS

In case of complaints, please contact the main organiser.

GPS AND BIB NUMBERS

The organisers will provide GPS devices for some competitors to monitor the race in real time. It is the responsibility of the competitor to take the GPS device with them on the course, and if the GPS device is left behind, the result may be cancelled. GPS devices will be distributed at the start. The names of the GPS carriers can be found on the competitions website.

On the second day, there are also bib numbers! **Please take your own pins!**

AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each stage. There will also be small prizes for those who complete the Nose Trail! The winners of the Ilves GP 2022 will be determined by the sum of the 4 stage times.

The overall winners will be rewarded after the 04.09 stage.

OTHER INFO

The organisation of the races will follow the guidelines and requirements for the organisation of sports competitions during the COVID-19 period. This is a public event, where photographs may be taken and filmed and the material recorded may be made public.

The minutes of the competition are public and may be used for statistical and historical purposes. The information requested from participants when registering for the competition will be used for organisational purposes.
